STATUS UPDATE: On Sunday, February 26, Mr. John Lutman, chair of the Pastor Parish Relations Committee, reported to the congregation, the serious financial concern that the church is several months behind in pastoral financial support, and could no longer afford a full-time fully ordained elder of the church to be pastor at Trinity.

On Sunday, March 5, at the end of our worship, I announced that Bishop Cynthia Moore-Koikoi, Bishop of the Western PA Annual Conference, is re-assigning me, to the Trinity Tower United Methodist Church in Penn Hills, PA, effective July 1, 2023.

The Pastor Parish Relations Committee will now be meeting with the District Superintendent, Rev. Ms. Deborah Ackley-Killian, to plan the best next steps for the church, within its current financial capabilities. In addition, I will be working with the Trustees, Treasurer, Pastor Parish Relations Committee, and the District Superintendent to apply for a financial grant to help the church in its emergency financial need.

THANK YOU: I want to thank the good people of Trinity for the privilege of serving the Lord with you for the past 7 years. We have made it through several challenging times together. (One of the important lessons Christians can teach is perseverance through adversity. We live by trust in God by faith, and always with hope!)

Thanks to the leadership for your growth in mutual support, vision, and high-quality service. Thanks to all the volunteers who have selflessly served in so many ways, always enjoying the experience, and sharing that joy, with all who have received your ministries.
